*Three interior designers deck the halls and bring their festive ideas to life for a Chatham home tour.*

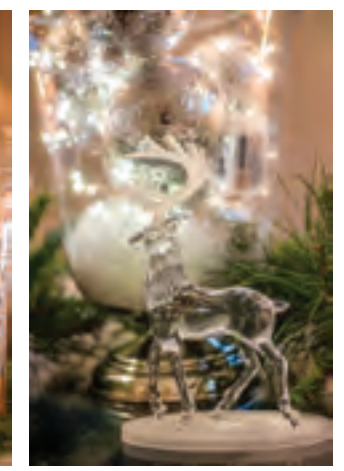
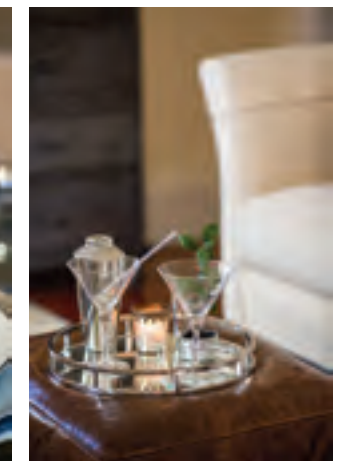
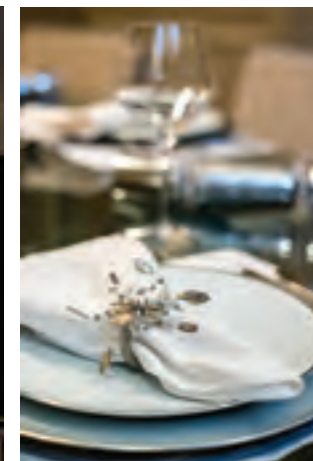

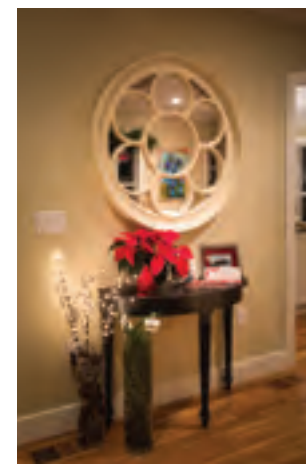
